

| Questions when you suspect demonic possession  | Yes/No |
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| <b>Thinking thoughts which are “not like you” or which “seem to come from somewhere else” or which “come out of the blue”.</b>   |        |
| <b>Sudden bouts of depression.</b><br>(Sometimes the depression is severe, sometimes it is very subtle)  |        |
| <b>Feeling like suicide, like life is not worth living or wondering why you are here.</b><br>(This could be failed attempts of suicide)  |        |
| <b>Having severe arguments with your spouse or friends.</b>  |        |
| <b>Feelings of hopelessness.</b>   |        |
| <b>Feeling like someone or something else is controlling you.</b><br>(You may feel controlled all the time or only some of the time)   |        |
| <b>Feeling like someone or something is pressuring you to do certain acts.</b>   |        |
| <b>Feeling something touch you, scratch you, or otherwise attack you.</b><br>(This could be in a sexual way)   |        |
| <b>Hearing one or multiple voices in your head that are negative, persuasive, or commanding you to do something.</b><br>(For example, hearing a voice persuade you that a certain friend should be avoided, or asking you to let them “in” to your life in some way)           |        |
| <b>Deep personality changes.</b><br>(For example, someone stays at home all the time when they used to be very outgoing)   |        |
| <b>Creepy feelings.</b>  |        |
| <b>An area of your house which feels negative or oppressive.</b>   |        |
| <b>Any kind of phenomena.</b><br>(For example, scratching sounds, things falling off walls or shelves, religious or spiritual items being moved or changed)  |        |
| <b>Feeling attacked when others do not see or experience anything.</b><br>(Sometimes this feeling of being attacked may come with physical pain that is medically inexplicable)<br>(Usually it will come with psychological pain of some sort – terror or anguish for example) |        |
| <b>An aversion to prayer or an inability to pray.</b>  |        |
| <b>Being unable to stand any contact with religious or spiritual items.</b><br>(For example, sudden strong aversion to going into a church or temple, aversion to being touched by a crucifix, and so on)  |        |
